
MICHIGAN RESIDENCY DOCUMENTS NEEDED TO APPLY FOR MARRIAGE LICENSE

- Marriage Application – go to <https://lcmivr.livgov.com/MLivingstonVS/Apex.WebPortal/applications> and fill in the application through our portal.
- Wait 3 days before coming to our office with all your documents.
- One (1) of the applicants must be a Livingston County resident with a Michigan Driver's License/State I.D. which shows a Livingston County address. Bring copies of both applicants' I.D.s.

*A photocopy or a picture on your smart phone of each applicant's I.D. is required
(also a copy/picture of the back of the I.D.)*

- Both applicants **MUST** be 18 years of age or older.
- **Certified Birth Certificates for each applicant.** Copies may be obtained from the Michigan Vital Records in Lansing **or the County** where the birth occurred. All certificates must be in English.
- **NOT ACCEPTABLE in place of CERTIFIED BIRTH CERTIFICATES:** Birth Registration/hospital certificate, US passport or foreign passport.
- Social security cards. If no cards, a W2 statement, paycheck stub, or tax return showing the social security number is acceptable.
- FEE of \$20.00-Payable in check, cash, or credit card. A service fee is added on all credit/debit card transactions. Fee is due at time of pickup.

Additional Information

- a. One (1) of the applicants **MUST** appear in person to apply.
- b. No need to make copies of your documents as we only verify the information and return all originals/copies to you.
- c. There is a three (3) day waiting period between the date of application and the date the license will be issued.
- d. The license is valid for 30 days after the issue date for a wedding ceremony ANYWHERE in the State of Michigan.
- e. Bring documents for BOTH applicants that are applying.
