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Public Notice – Seeking a Citizen Volunteer for the
Livingston County Tax Allocation Board

The Livingston County Board of Commissioners seek to fill a vacancy on the Tax Allocation Board for a member not officially connected with or employed by any local or county unit. In counties that have not adopted the fixed millage approach, a county allocation board in each county convenes on the third Monday in April to decide how the 15 (adjusted) mills are to be allocated. The basic duty of an allocation board is to review the budgets submitted by the various governmental units and to divide the 15 mills among them on the basis of what the board judges to be pertinent.

Compensation

Members of the Tax Allocation Board receive a per diem and any travel expenses for each meeting they attend.
